Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 3 (Two sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 22 of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The number of students in each section shall be restricted to 40. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school does not have a Ramp/lift to access the upper floors. Thus, the school is required to construct ramp/ lift to access the upper floors with proper incline and safety features as per the provisions laid down in RPWD Act and Board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance in SARAS Portal with videography.
3	The school does not have a concrete boundary wall of 6 ft from all the sides.(ref IC video-5.56). The school shall increase the length of the concrete boundary wall to 6 ft within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
4	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. Thus, the school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPWD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	Wooden tables should be replaced with marble/stone tops in all the labs. Plastic stool/chair should be replaced with metal/wooden stool. Existing workstations of all the labs should be replaced with permanent workstations with inbuilt utilities for the Chemistry and Bio sections and lab standard table for the Physics section. Storage and safety features are not adequate. The school shall upgrade the entire lab as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
6	Math lab is a temporary arrangement, with equipment displayed on tables covered with table cloth and no proper workstations. The school shall upgrade the entire lab as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
7	Separate reading areas for teachers are not seen in the Library. The school shall upgrade the lab as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	Benches/Pals tic Chair in Computer lab is not proper. Thus, the school should upgrade the lab and provide for computer chairs/straight back upholstered chairs for students seating as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
9	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Patna within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from

filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
